Newcomer Section: First place rosette kindly sponsored by Blue Chip. For registered Ponies in Grade JC & JD that have not won a total of 500 points to be ridden by Junior Members. 4 double clears recorded in the qualifying period of 1st May 2016-30th April 2017 will qualify to compete in the Pony Newcomers Second Round in 2017.

Open Section. For registered ponies ridden by registered junior members.

Restricted Rider: Ponies competing in either Section, where the rider has not won a total of 500 Points are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship.

Pony / Rider combinations recording 4 double clears during the qualifying period of 1st May 2016 to 30th April 2017 will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships.
