c.10am-11am Height of fences 65-75cm

c.11am-1pm Height of fences 80-90cm

c.1pm-3pm Height of fences 95cm-1.05m

c.3pm-4pm Height of fences 1.05-1.15m

c. 4pm - 1:20 or above on request/purchase of tickets by 3:45pm

Evening Session

c.5pm-6pm Height of fences 55-65cm

c.6pm-7pm Height of fences 70-80cm

c.7pm-8pm Height of fences 80-90cm

c.8pm – 1m or above <u>on request/purchase of tickets by 7:45pm*</u> (Last in ring strictly 8:30 pm)

(*note advance booking/payment can be made by card over the phone before 5pm on the day but the rounds must be jumped by 8.30 pm)

Please note that times stated are approximate and may alter slightly if demand at a particular level is high. In order to help us keep on schedule please ensure you arrive/buy your tickets at least 15 minutes before the published close of the relevant height.

WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRIES FOR ANY LEVEL AFTER THIS TIME.

Cost: £10 per one round jumped

Tickets must be purchased, in advance, at cafe and handed over at ring PRIOR TO JUMPING

Show attire unnecessary but note properly fitting hat and boots MUST be worn. No altering of fences allowed.

The organisers of these events have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone attending must also take all reasonable care to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must at all times obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards. Collecting ring for warm up of those who have made payment to jump only prior to jumping their round. Max. one helper permitted in ring during round – no chasing or use of lunge whips. Strictly no entry to ring without prepaid entry ticket.

One round per ticket – i.e Obstacles must be jumped in the order and direction numbered and <u>once only</u>,

though fences may be omitted.

The ring supervisor may permit repeated attempts on refusal at an obstacle, but **you must move on and omit the obstacle at the ring supervisor's direction** and may return at end of round to attempt one missed obstacle only with their express permission.
